In the first race, following a short delay to allow the wind to fill in, Woodcock finished first after almost an hour of close racing with Mackley just three minutes behind. On handicap the results were the same both helms being on 1%.

In the second race over a shorter course Mackley took the win after a little over half an hour with Woodcock second just a minute later. On handicap again the result was the same.

The trophies on the day are both awarded as the result of a series and with one race each it was basically a tie but under the last race rule David Mackley won both the "Moore Trophy" and "The 2000 Shield" with Sam Woodcock the runner up.
