

Frostbites host 90th Anniversary Open Event for Norfolk Dinghies.

On Sunday the rain from recent days necessitated waders to reach the clubhouse and no doubt put potential visiting crews off. In the end five resident boats were launched and OOD Paul Tegerdine assisted by Pat Tegerdine as timekeeper set a simple two mark course, top and lower, both to starboard. The first two races were to qualify for the normal club series and in combination with the third for the 90th Anniversary Cup on a best two out of three basis.

In blustery conditions the first race was won by David Mackley who lead from the start sailing B6 "Lucifer beyond repair" crewed by Olivia Archer, closely followed about a minute later by Sam Woodcock sailing B20 "Kelpie" and crewed by Sam Archer. In third place came Mike Gilbert, sailing B15 "Wee Simby" and crewed by Judy Fisk.

Similar conditions in the second race gave another win to Mackley but this time Gilbert was closing in and finished just six seconds behind. Third came David Yapp in B50 "Dodman" crewed by Abigail Stevenson. The positions on handicap for both races were unchanged.

The final race saw a win for Woodcock with Gilbert again second. This time Mackley was third but with two wins he won the Anniversary Cup.
