

Four boats risk strong wind conditions at Frostbites

With a forecast of high winds many helms were no doubt put off from sailing but on the day conditions were benign and four boats took to the water.

Commodore Jean Board as Race Officer assisted by Phil Board set a four lap upstream course, later shortened to three. In the first race David Mackley sailing Lucifer and crewed by Olivia Archer set the pace and built on a commanding lead to win after 40 minutes. Sam Woodcock sailing Kelpie and crewed by Sam Archer was second, 3 minutes behind and in third place was Danny Tyrrell sailing Twinkle and crewed by Bruce Thompson. On handicap Tyrrell took the win with Mackley second and Woodcock third.

In the second race Sam Archer now helming Kelpie and crewed by Woodcock took the lead closely followed by Olivia Archer crewed by Mackley in Lucifer. Sam beat Olivia by just 2 minutes but Tyrrell came between them and took second place. On handicap Olivia took the win with Sam second and Tyrrell third.
