

Lively conditions at Frostbites

Eight Norfolk Dinghies and one Enterprise prepared to sail on Sunday but with rather a gusty wind a couple of crews thought better of it. Race Officer Sam Woodcock, assisted by Wendy Bush set an upstream course from "C" line.

In the first race of three laps David Mackley Lucifer crewed by Sam Archer set the pace followed by David Yapp and Julia Deary in Dodman and Danny Tyrrell with Bruce Thompson in Twinkle. An interesting lower middle buoy made for a tactical approach when coming back up river against the tide. After 31 minutes Mackley finished first, Yapp second 3 minutes later, just keeping ahead of Tyrrell only 30 seconds behind. On handicap Yapp took the win, Mackley second and Tyrrell third.

In the second race of four laps Sam Archer took the helm of Lucifer and lead from the start winning after 45 minutes. Yapp was second a minute and a half later with Tyrrell again third. On handicap the results were unchanged.
