At the end of the first lap the Armitages took the lead with Danny Tyrrell crewed by Ethan Lewis in B53 "Twinkle" close behind and Woodcock behind. Woodcock eventually pulled through to win with Armitage second and Tyrrell third. On handicap Armitage came first, Woodcock second and Mike Readhead crewed by Jess Readhead in the sole Enterprise third.

The second race started with three boats over the line, Tyrrell got a flying start followed by Sam Archer who now helmed B20. These two boats pulled out a commanding lead and finished in that order, with Armitage recovering to third. On handicap the positions remained unchanged.
