

Woodcock and Archer share the wining positions at Frostbites

On a cold but lovely Sunday morning five Norfolk Dinghy crews launched under the supervision of Geoff Evans as Officer of the Day assisted by Bruce Thompson as timekeeper.

In the first race the usual battle took place between Sam Woodcock sailing B20 "Kelpie" crewed by Sam Archer, and David Mackley in B6 "Lucifer beyond Repair" crewed by Olivia Archer. After 45 minutes Woodcock came in first with Mackley second just over a minute later. In third place came Paul Armitage in B60 "Jane" crewed by Karen Armitage. On handicap Armitage took the win, with Woodcock second and Mackley third.

In the second race with Sam and Olivia Archer both helming, Sam came in first, Olivia second and again in third place it was Armitage. On handicap Sam Archer retained his lead, as did Olivia still second and Armitage again third.

Next Sunday will be the last of the series races as after that the Club commence four downriver races followed by the passage race on 27th April to Coldham Hall Sailing Club ready for the Regatta the following weekend.
